


Caxton's Objective

The primary objective of Caxton Brickwork is to provide high levels of quality andworkmanship by using a small and consistentteam of highly skilled tradesmen. Wespecialise in brick facework and blockwork innew builds, alterations to existing buildingsand extensions around East Anglia and the East Midlands. The company is a subsidiary of SDC Builders Ltd, a main contractor that was established in 1972.

Our Philosophy

Quality is paramount to the success of the company which is maintained by regular monitoring, training and consistent employment. A strong emphasis is also placed on delivering on time and within budget.

Our small, dedicated and hard-working group of tradesmen produce high quality workmanship on a variety of projects, most recently completing prestigious and complex schemes for the University of Cambridge.

We can be extremely flexible, with projects spanning from a single day's work for a bricklayer to masonry packages with a value of £700,000.

Cost and buildability advice is available at pricing stage and is monitored regularly throughout the build process.

Led by Kevin Watkins, a manager with over 30 years' trade experience, the team consists of 14 bricklayers as well as hod carriers, labourers and forklift drivers.

All operatives are trained to the highest safety standards and hold current Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) cards, the large majority being Advanced Craft Gold. Other qualifications include Site Management Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS) and Site Supervisor Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS).

Caxton Brickwork also employs several apprentices, two of whom have won Cambridgeshire's Apprentice of the Year Award and three who have been presented with the CITB Regional Skillbuild Award.

All team members are directly employed on a day rate basis to ensure maximum quality, workmanship and safety levels.

SDC was the first company in the construction industry to implement an Employers Benefit Trust (EBT) and all employees within the brickwork department are included within it, meaning that they have a vested interest in each project and benefit from that project's success.
